

General Information about the Yalta International Economic Forum

Yalta International Economic Forum will be held on April 14-16, 2016 in Yalta, Russia. The Forum is a modern platform for a constructive dialogue between business and government, set up with support of the Administration of the President of the Russian Federation and the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Crimea, to promote successful implementation of investment potential of the Crimea as a federal subject of the Russian Federation.

Second Yalta International Economic Forum will be addressed to establishing favourable conditions for business practices in the context of a unique in the Russian Federation free trade area and investment attraction to the economy of the whole country and the Crimean peninsula in particular. The emphasis of the discussions will also be centered on the outlook for investment and innovation of the peninsula and showcasing most ambitious investment projects in regard to the Federal Targeted Social and Economic Development Programme of the Republic of Crimea and federal city Sevastopol.

Programme of the Forum will involve Plenary meeting, sectoral discussions and business breakfasts. Plenary session as a key event of the Forum will reveal most relevant issues relating to the economic and investment future of the Crimean peninsula.

Business programme of the Forum will be focused on discussions of the best regional development practices and entrepreneurship support, investment climate improvement, international cooperation and Russian economy competitiveness growth.

First Yalta International Economic Forum took place in the year 2015 and gathered more than 600 participants, including 34 foreign business representatives from 13 countries all over the world. As a result of the Forum 5 residents of free trade area of the Republic of Crimea were declared and 33 investment agreements were concluded. The event involved 56 journalists of federal and regional level and was broadly covered in media.
